



Regulations of the Gran Fondo Gdynia (hereinafter referred to as: "Event")

I. ORGANIZER

- 1.1. The organizer of the Event is Sport Evolution Group Sp. z o. o with headquarters 01-864 Warszawa, ul. Jana Kochanowskiego 12/23, registered in the District Court for the capital city of Warsaw, 14th Commercial Division of the National Court Register, KRS 0000779253, NIP: 1231431002, REGON: 382960037, mailing address ul. Janki, ul. Falencka 1B, 05-090 Raszyn (hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer").

II. DEFINITIONS

- 2.1. **Organizer** - an entity performing activities necessary to organize the Event;
- 2.2. **Athlete** - a person who has been registered for the Event by completing the registration form and paying the entry fee;
- 2.3. **Entry fee** - the fee that must be paid to register for the event;
- 2.4. **Withdrawal** - resignation from participation in the Event, resignation means deleting the Athlete from the list of Event participants;
- 2.5. **Transfer** - transferring the entry fee to another Event, transfer means deleting the Athlete from the list of Event participants;
- 2.6. **Start Area (Start)** - a designated area where Athlete s begin their participation in the Event;
- 2.7. **Finish Zone (Finish)** - a separate area where Athlete s finish their participation in the Event;
- 2.8. **Race Office** - a separate area where Athlete s collect items necessary to take part in the Event;
- 2.9. **Website of the Event** - the official website of the Event, www.gfgdynia.pl
- 2.10. **Service** - an additional service purchased by the Athlete, which is not included in the starting fee.

III. GENERAL RULES

- 3.1. Out of concern for the safety of the Athlete s, Volunteers and Organizers, the Event will be organized in a sanitary regime. The rules were developed on the basis of the guidelines of the Ministry of Culture and National Heritage, the Ministry of Development and the Chief Sanitary Inspector. The rules apply to the organization of mass events during the SARS-Cov-2 virus pandemic and the Act of March 2, 2020 on special solutions related to the prevention, prevention and combating of COVID-19, other infectious diseases and crisis situations caused by them (Journal of Laws No.. of 2020, item 374)

IV. DATE AND PLACE

- 4.1. The Event will take place on June 27, 2021 in Gdynia.
- 4.2. Start and Finish will be located on Aleja Jana Pawła II in Gdynia.
- 4.3. The start time of the Event will be published in the "Program of the event" on the event website at a later date.



- 4.4. Start will be divided into time zones, separate for both distances. The Athlete will be allocated to the zone in accordance with the time of their completion of the Event.
- 4.5. Athletes registered after May 31 will be assigned to the last start zone.

V. DISTANCE, COURSE, TIME LIMIT

- 5.1. The Event will be held at the following distances:
 - 5.1.1. Gran Fondo - 134 km, time limit: 7 hours
 - 5.1.2. Medio Fondo - 80 km, time limit: 4 hours
- 5.2. To participate in the Event is allowed bikes are depending on selected distance:
 - 5.2.1. Gran Fondo - Road bikes only
 - 5.2.2. Medio Fondo - all roadworthy technical bikes, except those described in point 5.3.
- 5.3. Triathlon bikes, time trial bikes, bikes with aerobars, tandems, recumbent bikes, bicycles and unicycles are not allowed during the Event.
- 5.4. Limit the time of completion of the individual sections of the course will be published on the website of the Event no later than 30 days before the Event.
- 5.5. The detailed course of the Event will be published on the Event website. The organizer has the right to change the course. Such a change does not result in any additional claims and obligations.
- 5.6. Apart from the Organizer, no persons without a Bib number may be on the course of the Event. Persons violating this prohibition may be removed from the race course by the relevant services.
- 5.7. Electronic time control checkpoints will be located on the course of the Event. Omitting the control gate may result in disqualification.
- 5.8. Refreshing points will be located on the course of the Event.
- 5.9. After the limit referred to in point 5.4., The Athlete is obliged to immediately leave the course of the Event.
- 5.10. A person who stays on the course after this time, does it at own risk and may be punished for breaking the road traffic regulations and other applicable laws.

VI. PARTICIPATION

- 6.1. A person who is 18 years of age at the latest on the day of the Event (persons born before June 26, 2003) may participate in the Event.
- 6.2. Each Athlete must be verified at the Event Office.
- 6.3. The condition for positive verification is the personal appearance of the Athlete and submission to the Race Office of the confirmation of the application in the form of a QR ticket and an identity document or passport.
- 6.4. The QR ticket will be available to the Athlete up to 7 days before the Event.
- 6.5. The opening hours of the Race Athlete will be published in the Program of the event on the website of the Event.
- 6.6. Each Athlete is obliged to:
 - 6.6.1. Wear a fastened helmet for the duration of the Event.
 - 6.6.2. Start in the official jersey of the Event.
 - 6.6.3. Attach the starting numbers in the places indicated by the Organizer.
 - 6.6.4. Wearing a wristband from the moment of receiving the package until the end of the Event.
- 6.7. The cost of the entry fee, accommodation, travel and own meals are covered by the Athlete on his own.



- 6.8. Athlete s who take part in the Event under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be disqualified from the Event and will be suspended from the right to participate in the Event organized by the Sport Evolution Group Sp. z o. o. and related entities organizing sports events for 2 years.

VII. SAFETY

- 7.1. By entering the starting line, the Athlete confirms that he starts solely at his own risk and bears the related risk, acknowledging that participation in the Event is associated with physical effort and entails a natural risk and risk of accidents, the possibility of body injuries and injuries, physical damage (including death) as well as property damage and loss, and has voluntarily decided to take the risk. The above does not exclude the Organizer's liability resulting from mandatory provisions of law.
- 7.2. Participants are obliged to strictly follow the instructions of the Organizer, services responsible for road traffic management, including the Police, Municipal Police, Referees and other services securing the course of the Event.
- 7.3. For safety reasons, the use of headphones and mobile devices during the Event is prohibited.
- 7.4. The decisions of the medical service regarding the continuation of the Event by the Participant are final and indisputable. The medical transport of the Athlete results in his disqualification.
- 7.5. Organizer provides accident insurance policy for Athlete s, who have been properly verified and the Event Office. Each Athlete will be covered by insurance in the field of accident insurance occurring during the insurer's liability period in the territory of the Republic of Poland, consisting in body injury or health disorder, causing permanent health impairment or death of the insured. The Policy is paid by the Policyholder, ie the Organizer.
- 7.6. If a Athlete decides to withdraw from the Event at any time of the Event, he is obliged to report this fact to the Referees or the Organizer.
- 7.7. To reduce the risk of contracting Covid-19, we recommend that all people diagnosed with one of the following conditions: pregnancy, diabetes, high blood pressure, recent stroke, chronic lung or heart disease, chronic renal failure with dialysis, chronic liver disease with cirrhosis, decreased immune function did not participate in the event.
- 7.8. While staying at the Event site and moving on the premises of the facility, Athlete s should comply with the applicable regulations, in particular move in a manner ensuring social distancing and stay at a safe distance from each other, in accordance with the current guidelines of the Ministry of Health and the Chief Sanitary Inspector, WHO and regulations. rights. - 7.9. It is forbidden to enter the Event by persons staying in quarantine, under epidemiological supervision or showing signs of infection (fever, cough, shortness of breath). Each Athlete undertakes to submit to routine temperature checks.
- 7.10. Each Athlete is required to complete a screening questionnaire, which will be included in the QR ticket.
- 7.11. Each Athlete is required to: cover his mouth and nose with a mask, and disinfect his hands upon entering the Event area (ie. Event Office, Expo, Start Zone, Finish Zone).



- 7.12. Avoid pooling and squeezing when passing doors, walkways, corridors and toilets. Each Athlete undertakes to follow the written and oral instructions given by the Organizer in the above-mentioned scope.
- 7.13. The possession of nose and mouth protection is obligatory and is a condition of participation in the Event.
- 7.14. Uncovering the mouth and nose is only possible if a person needs to be identified or verified.
- 7.15. When coughing or sneezing, it is recommended that you cover your mouth and nose with a bent elbow or a tissue, which should be disposed of immediately in a waste container and your hands thoroughly washed or disinfected with an alcohol-based disinfectant.
- 7.16. The Athlete declares that he is aware of the degree of risk incurred when it comes to infection with the COVID - 19 virus during the Event. He is aware that despite the introduction of a sanitary regime and compliance with appropriate procedures by the Organizer, there is a risk of infection.
- 7.17. The Athlete declares that has read the epidemic safety rules applicable during the Event and undertakes to comply with them.
- 7.18. The Athlete declares that he will not make any claims against the Organizer in the event of being infected with the COVID-19 virus during the Event.

VIII. REGISTRATION

- 8.1. Registrations for the Event will be accepted via the application form available at SlotMarket.pl.
- 8.2. Online applications will be accepted until June 20, 2021 or until there are places available.
- 8.3. The limit of athletes in the Event is 2000 places.
- 8.4. If the limit is reached, the Organizer reserves the right to close the registration earlier.
- 8.5. The organizer reserves the right to invite people to take part in the Event after the limit of places has been reached.
- 8.6. The organizer reserves the right to change the limit of places, and everyone who has purchased the package by the date of announcement of such a change has a guaranteed right to start.
- 8.7. The application is deemed to be the delivery of a correctly completed application form and payment of the entry fee in the amount specified in these regulations.
- 8.8. The confirmation of successful registration is:
 - confirmation of registration for the Event from the website of SlotMarket.pl (confirmation from the address contact@slotmarket.pl)
 - payment confirmation from the DotPay portal (confirmation from transkacje@dotpay.pl)
 - information about registration in the Reports History on the SlotMarket.pl user account (status: "Registered").

IX. GROUP REGISTRATION

- 9.1. Group registration are accepted via the e-mail address: faktury@slotmarket.pl.
- 9.2. Payment for group applications is made to the Organiser's bank account on the basis of the Pro-Forma document. A Pro-Forma document is issued for the start of at least five participants (it is not possible to receive a Pro-Form for starting a group of up to four people and for an individual start).
- 9.3. Group applications are accepted up to 30 days before the closing of the registration form.



- 9.4. In order to receive a Pro-Forma document, please send: invoice details and the number of participants to the address faktury@slotmarket.pl.
- 9.5. After making the payment for the Pro-Forma document, registration codes will be sent, reducing the starting fee.
- 9.6. Registration codes are valid for 14 days from the date of receipt of the codes.
- 9.7. People registering with codes are required to complete the Event registration form available on the SlotMarket.pl website and provide the code in the last step of registration.
- 9.8. Persons who do not register using the code will not be admitted to the Event.
- 9.9. Persons who have registered using a group application are not covered by the transfer and resignation policy described in Chapter XIII.

X. STARTING FEE

10.1. The starting fee for participation in the Event, depending on the order of payment, is:

The first 250 slots - PLN 250

next 250 slots - PLN 260

next 250 slots - PLN 270

next 250 slots - PLN 280

next 250 slots - PLN 290

next 250 slots - PLN 300

next 250 slots - PLN 310

last 250 slots - PLN 320

10.2. For people who have registered for Gran Fondo Gdynia 2020 by April 10, 2020, the entry fee is PLN 250, until April 30, 2021.

10.3. The starting fee should be paid via the DotPay transaction service. All data provided in payments are entered on a secure encrypted page.

10.4. The fee must be paid upon registration, otherwise the application will be cancelled.

10.5. The Entry Fee consists of servicing the Athlete before the Event (e-mail communication and via Social Media channels), maintaining the servers of the Event Website, purchasing and renting equipment to organize the Event, the starter package, organization and promotion of the Event.

10.6. A Athlete who wants to receive an invoice for the paid entry fee should select the appropriate option in the application form and enter the required data needed to issue the document. The invoice will be generated automatically after the payment is credited and will be available for download from the profile of a given participant.

10.7. In accordance with tax regulations, due to the payment made before the service is provided, an advance invoice will be issued covering the full amount of the fee paid. Thus, the advance invoice is also the final invoice. By selecting the Invoice option, the Participant agrees to sending / sharing invoices without the recipient's signature, in electronic form.

10.8. The organizer does not issue invoices in paper form.

10.9. If the Athlete requests an invoice after the payment has been made, the invoice will be issued only to a natural person. The invoice may be requested by writing to the address faktury@slotmarket.pl until the end of the Event.

XI. STARTER PACK

11.1. As part of the Event, each participant receives:



- the number of s starting
- wristband
- chip
- official jersey
- food voucher

11.2. Athlete s who complete the Event will get a medal.

11.3. The size of the Official jersey must be provided during registration. The size of the Official jersey can be changed up to 2 months days before the Event.

11.4. The basis for collecting the starter package is scanning the QR code at the Race Office and verification of data on the basis of an identity card or passport.

11.5. During the collection of the starter package, the Athlete is obliged to wear a wristband. The wristband should be put on by the volunteer.

11.6. The location and opening hours of the Race Office will be given in the Event program on the Event Website.

11.7. The Athlete is obliged to collect the package himself and to bring the bike to / from the Transition Zone and pick it up.

11.8. Packages that are not collected during the Race Office's working hours will not be issued or sent out at a later date.

XII. ADDITIONAL SERVICES

12.1. During registration for the Event and after its completion, the Athlete may purchase additional Services.

12.2. The purchase of Services is not obligatory and is not a prerequisite for the completion of the Event. The purchase of Services is possible up to 7 days before the date of the Event.

12.3. The services that the Athlete may purchase are:

- Additional food voucher
- Photo Package
- Photos + video package from the finish line
- Medal engraving
- Overnight stay at a hotel
- Cancellation Insurance (purchase only possible during registration)
- Additional Personal Accident Insurance (purchase possible only during registration)
- Starting kit delivery

12.4. The price for the Service is given in the Event registration form on the Slotmarket.pl

12.5. The Athlete has the option to resign from the purchased services up to 45 days before the Event. At a later date, it will not be possible to resign from the purchased Services.

12.6. In the event of resignation from the Service, the Athlete will be reimbursed the fee for the purchased service, less the cost of its return in accordance with the rules of service provision by the payment operator.

12.7. The following are not refundable:

- Cancellation Insurance
- Additional Personal Accident Insurance

12.8. Insurance policies against cancellation costs and Personal Accident Insurance are purchased at the TU Europa Insurance Company, via the Slotmarket.pl portal. In this relation, the Organizer acts as an intermediary and not an insurer.

12.9. When purchasing the Cancellation Insurance and Personal Accident Insurance, the Athlete accepts the General Terms and Conditions of Insurance.



- 12.10. Insured that the insured costs of resignation and an Accident can be purchased only when registering for the event.
- 12.11. Athletes who bought a Photo Package and a Photo Package + video from the finish line will be delivered up to 7 days from the end of the Event.
- 12.12. In the case of the "Starting kit delivery" service, the terms and conditions of the service apply.

XIII. WITHDRAWAL AND TRANSFERS

- 13.1. Except for the situations provided for in these regulations, the Organizer does not provide for the possibility of transferring the paid entry fee to another participant or to another year.
- 13.2. Resignation from the Event should be reported via the form. The amount of the refund of the starting fee depends on the date of application:
 - up to 45 days before the Event (i.e. until May 13, 2021) we refund: 25% of the starting fee;
 - less than 45 days before the Event (i.e. after May 13, 2021), the entry fee is not returned.The above is due to the necessity to undertake and pay for activities aimed at organizing the Event.
- 13.3. It is possible to transfer the entry fee to another Gran Fondo Series event taking place in 2021.
- 13.4. The transfer fee is PLN 39.
- 13.5. In the event of transferring the entry fee to a Event where the entry fee is lower than the paid one, the difference in entry fees will not be refunded.
- 13.6. In the event of transferring the entry fee to a Event where the entry fee is higher than the fee paid, the difference in the price of the fees will be added to the registration.
- 13.7. The entry fee cannot be transferred to a sold-out event.
- 13.8. The willingness to transfer the starting fee should be reported 45 days before the Event for which the Athlete is registered.
- 13.9. It is not possible to transfer the purchased additional services to other Professions. In the event of transferring the Professionals to other professions, the fee for additional services will be refunded.
- 13.10. Sponsorship, charity and other packages not covered by the starting fee are excluded from transfers.
- 13.11. The transfer can only be made once.
- 13.12. Events to be transferred must have open registration for at least 10 days from the date of submission of the transfer application.
- 13.13. In the event of using the option to transfer the entry fee, the Athlete resigns from the Resignation and Transfer Policy applicable to the Event to which the Athlete wishes to transfer.
- 13.14. The transfer of the starting fee to other Events should be reported via the form.
- 13.15. Changing the distance within one Event is possible up to 45 days before the Event.
- 13.16. Change of distance should be reported via the form.
- 13.17. During registration for the Event, the Athlete has the option to take out additional insurance "Against the costs of resignation". The insurance is purchased through the Organizer via the Slotmarket.pl portal at the TU Europa Insurance Company.

XIV. CLASSIFICATION AND AWARDS

- 14.1. The following classifications will be conducted as part of the Event :



14.1.1. For Gran Fondo and Medio Fondo distances

14.1.1.1. Year of birth determines belonging to the age category.

14.1.1.2. The Athlete who receives the prize in the general classification will not receive the prizes in the age category.

14.1.2. The team classification will be conducted on the basis of the club name entered in the application form. The time of the top five people on each team, including one woman, will be taken into account.

14.2. The results will be announced no later than 15 minutes before the awards ceremony. The results will be hosted on the timekeeping company's website.

14.3. The results will be published on the Event website and reported to the media.

14.4. In the event of absence from the award ceremony, the prizes can only be collected at the Organizer's office up to 30 days after the end of the Event

14.5. The winners of places 1-3 in the age categories of women and men will receive commemorative statuettes.

14.6. The organizer reserves the right to introduce additional prizes in selected categories.

XV. PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION

15.1. The administrator of the players' personal data is Sport Evolution Group Sp. z o. o with headquarters 01-864 Warszawa, ul. Jana Kochanowskiego 12/23, contact regarding personal data at: daneosobowe@sporteolution.pl.

15.2. Athlete s' personal data will be processed for the purposes of organizing and conducting the Event, selecting the winner and awarding, issuing, receiving and settling the prize and other activities related to the conducted business activity.

15.3. In order to measure the time, create results, send information about the start number and the result obtained, the data of participants will be transferred to Datasport Marek Zieliński, ul. Okręna 22, 58-310 Szczawno Zdrój NIP: 886-002-17-67.

15.4. The participant has the right to access their data and correct them. Providing personal data and consenting to their processing is voluntary, but necessary to achieve the above-mentioned purposes. Failure to provide data or lack of consent to their processing prevents participation in the Event. Please be advised that your consent may be revoked at any time, but its revocation does not affect the correctness of data processing so far.

15.5. Processing of participants' data in connection with participation in the Event also includes the publication of the name and surname, year of birth, participant's club together with the name of the city in which he lives.

15.6. All information about participants, obtained by the Organizer and contained in the registration form, will be saved electronically and in any case will be used in accordance with applicable law.



- 15.7. The organizer reserves the right to conduct an interview with each of the participants, take photos and film them for advertising, promotional purposes, use on the Internet or in radio and TV broadcasts, and for other commercial purposes.
- 15.8. The organizer reserves the right to use, free of charge, all photos, films, interviews and audio recordings of the Event participants worldwide. They can be used by the Organizer by placing them on CD-ROMs, DVDs, catalogues and medias, on websites, in newspapers and at exhibitions, as well as for promotional and advertising purposes related to the activities carried out by the Organizer.

XVI. COMPLAINTS

- 16.1. Complaints regarding matters related to the Event should be submitted in writing with justification to the Organizer's correspondence address, with the note " Gran Fondo Gdynia - Complaint", within 7 days from the date of the event - directly or by registered mail (date as postmarked) or to the address: contact@slotmarket.pl with the title " Gran Fondo Gdynia - Complaint".
- 16.2. Complaints sent after the deadline in point 16.1 will not be considered.
- 16.3. Complaints regarding the Event will be considered by the Organizer within 60 days from the date of their receipt.
- 16.4. The Organizer's decision on complaints regarding the Event will be final.
- 16.5. The above does not limit the Consumer's rights to pursue his claims on the basis of mandatory provisions of law before common courts.

XVII. FINAL PROVISIONS

- 17.1. These regulations apply to all participants of the Event.
- 17.2. The regulations apply from the date of its announcement.
- 17.3. Each participant is obliged to read the regulations.
- 17.4. Ignorance of the Event Regulations does not release the Athlete from the rules specified by the Organizer in these Regulations.
- 17.5. It is forbidden to bring drugs, illegal performance-enhancing substances and alcohol to the venue. Participants are prohibited from taking such drugs and substances both before and during the Event, under pain of exclusion from them. If it is found that a participant violates the above prohibition, the organizer reserves the right not to allow him to participate in the Event or to exclude him during the Event.
- 17.6. No Athlete may use measures or actions to increase efficiency. Athletes may be required to undergo tests before and after the Event. If the Athlete is called for inspection, he is required to report to the inspection.
- 17.7. Each participant who transfers and purchases a starting package without reporting this fact to the organizer may be disqualified as well as suspended from the right to participate in events organized by Sport Evolution Group Sp. z o. o. and related entities organizing sports events for 2 years.
- 17.8. On the reverse of the bib number there will be a table that each Athlete should fill in for easier identification in the event of an accident. The table contains data on medications taken, possible allergies and the telephone number of the person to be contacted by the Organizer in the event of an accident.
- 17.9. The organizer provides emergency medical care along the course and at the finish of the Event.



- 17.10. The organizer provides a deposit. Valuables may not be left in the deposit, only things necessary to meet basic needs both before and after the Event. It is forbidden to deposit keys and access devices to cars and real estate, documents confirming identity, as well as cash and credit / debit cards.
- 17.11. The organizer is not responsible for items lost during the event.
- 17.12. The organizer takes responsibility only for the equipment necessary to complete the Event, i.e. bicycle, helmet.
- 17.13. In the event of theft or damage to the equipment, each participant is obliged to report this fact to the Organizer's representative in the transition zone and the police. Applications will be accepted by the Organizer only until the Athlete collects the equipment and leaves the Transition Zone.
- 17.14. Absence at the technical briefing does not release the participant from complying with the rules introduced at this briefing.
- 17.15. In the event of cancellation or rescheduling of the Event due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Athlete agrees to receive a voucher with the value of the paid entry fee to be used for the Event taking place during Gran Fondo Poznań 2021 or Gran Fondo Series in 2022. The money for the purchased additional services will be returned to the Athlete within 90 days. The purchased accident insurance, insurance against "cancellation costs" shall not be refunded.
- 17.16. Only the organizer of the Event is entitled to a binding and final interpretation of the regulations of these regulations. If any of the provisions of the Regulations is partially or fully changed - all other provisions remain valid.
- 17.17. The organizer reserves the right to change the name of the Event.
- 17.18. In matters not covered by the regulations, the Organizer decides on the basis of applicable law. The above does not limit the right to a court in the event of a dispute.
